



## CITY OF PATASKALA

### COUNCIL MEETING

January 9, 2010

The Council of the City of Pataskala continued their organizational session on January 9, 2010 at 8:30 AM at City Hall, located at 621 W. Broad Street. The pledge of allegiance was given. Roll Call: Brush, Lenzo, McKinstry, Raybourne and Sagar-present. King and Triplett were absent. Mayor Stephen J. Butcher presiding.

Mayor Butcher called for any public comment. There was none.

McKinstry made a motion to nominate Barb Triplett as President of Council. Seconded by Sagar.

Brush called for a point of order that nominations do not require a second. Mayor Butcher ruled that he will continue as was done at the last meeting.

Brush made a motion to nominate Brian Raybourne as President of Council. Mayor Butcher declares motion dies for lack of a second.

Raybourne made a motion to nominate Merissa McKinstry as President of Council. Seconded by Brush.

Roll Call on the re-appointment of Barb Triplett as President of Council: Brush-no, McKinstry-yes, Lenzo-yes, Raybourne-yes, and Sagar-yes. Mayor Butcher declares the motion passed.

Roll Call on the appointment of Merissa McKinstry as President of Council: McKinstry-no, Lenzo-yes, Raybourne-yes, and Sagar-no, and Brush-yes. Mayor Butcher declares the motion failed.

Raybourne made a motion to nominate Pat Sagar as Vice President of Council. Seconded by Lenzo.

Brush made a motion to nominate Merissa McKinstry as Vice President of Council. Seconded by Raybourne.

Roll Call on the re-appointment of Pat Sagar as Vice President of Council: Lenzo-yes, Raybourne-yes, Sagar-yes, Brush-no, McKinstry-yes. Mayor Butcher declared the motion passed.

Roll Call on the appointment of Merissa McKinstry as Vice President of Council: Raybourne-yes, Sagar-no, Brush-yes, McKinstry-no, and Lenzo-yes. Mayor Butcher declared the motion failed.

McKinstry made a motion to continue with the same meeting schedule as in 2009 and as presented. Seconded by Sagar. Discussion was regarding if an alternate date might allow for better citizen attendance and the affect of any changes on other public bodies. Roll Call: Sagar, Brush, McKinstry, Lenzo, and Raybourne-yes. Mayor Butcher declared the motion passed.

Brush made a motion to continue with the Council Rules of Order. Seconded by Raybourne. Roll Call: Brush, McKinstry, Lenzo, Raybourne, and Sagar-yes. Mayor Butcher declared the motion passed.

Lenzo presented a proposed amendment to Council Rules of Order to add a period of Citizens Comments at the end of Council Meetings. Discussion was regarding the support for this change and the amount of time to be provided to the citizens.

Brush presented a proposed amendment to Section 9.01 Members' Right to Speak




