COUNCIL STUDY SESSION

September 20, 2010

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in study session on September 20, 2010 at 6:30 PM in City Hall located at 621 W. Broad Street. Roll Call: Brush, Gernert, Hayes, Lenzo, McKinstry, Sagar, and Triplett-present. Council President Triplett presiding and Law Director Rufus B. Hurst were present.

Tim Boland, City Administrator noted concerns regarding the speed limits set on Main Street. He explained a desire to lower the speed limit to 25 mph for this entire section. Hayes expressed concern that the entire area between Mill Street and Broad Street may not fit the description of a Business District.

Mr. Boland gave a grant update and reported in the last three years the City is at a level of 3.1 million dollars.

Mr. Boland reported efforts to coordinate a rededication of Taylor Road along with the new COTC Campus.

Mr. Boland reported on the leases that were about to expire or renew.

Mr. Boland reviewed the agenda items for this evening.

Brush expressed concerns regarding adopting the Revitalization Plan prior to receiving input from the residents at the upcoming Community Meeting.


Mr. Boland explained that the plan is a set of stated goals.
