COUNCIL WORKSHOP

October 11, 2010

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in Workshop Session on October 11, 2010 at 6:30 PM in City Hall located at 621 W. Broad Street. Roll Call: Gernert, Hayes, Lenzo, Sagar, and Triplett- present. Brush and McKinstry were absent. Mayor Stephen J. Butcher presiding and Law Director Rufus B. Hurst were present.

Tim Boland, City Administrator announced that Value King had closed. Mayor and Council discussed what could be done to assist local businesses.

Mr. Boland gave an update on the Business Retention and Expansion Program, Sign Code Review, and infrastructure improvements.

Mr. Boland reported that the JEDD Board has issued a request for proposals for marketing services.

Mr. Boland announced that the JEDD Board would be meeting on October 20th at 3:30 PM. Mr. Boland discussed meeting dates for an Annual Meeting.

Mr. Boland announced that the TRAC application for a railroad spur would be presented this Thursday.

Mr. Boland reported that the Community meeting with residents was very successful. He also gave an update on the CHIP Program and targeted incentive areas. Jason Carr, Finance Director suggested that this be considered an investment as we move forward.

Mr. Boland reported on the Waste Water Treatment Plant financing and that construction will start in November.

Mr. Boland gave a project update on the Summit Road South Reconstruction project, Old Maids Lane Bridge Reconstruction, Town Hall/Police Department tuck pointing, windows and basement improvements. Mr. Boland noted the contributions from the Not for Profit group.

Gernert asked about a timeline for a crosswalk at Summit and Broad Street. The Mayor and Mr. Boland explained the grant process.

Mayor Butcher announced that he had been appointed to Etna Township's Task Force and provided Council with a copy of the letter he had received and gave an update regarding this committee.

Mr. Boland reported that the Charter Review Commission will be providing a power point presentation of their final report.

Council discussed the December meeting schedule.


Kathy Hoskinson reported that she has completed the records training requirement on behalf of the Mayor and Council.


