



ORDINANCE NO. 2010-3976

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2000-3346 AND 2004-3592 WHICH WERE ESTABLISHED TO CREATE A NEW POSITION OF EMPLOYMENT WITHIN THE CITY OF PATASKALA AND TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, On or about July 17, 2000 and December 20, 2004, Council adopted Ordinance 2000-3346 and 2004-3592, respectively, establishing the creation of a new position of employment within the City of Pataskala and establishing compensation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2000-3346 and 2004-3346 make no distinction between the “short term” absence of the duly serving Acting City Administrator as a consequence of business away from the City, vacation or short term illness and a more extended vacancy in the position of City Administrator as a consequence of the death, retirement or termination of employment; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Ordinance 2000-3346 and 2004-3592 are no longer adequate to address the distinctions between the short term, occasional needs to designate an Acting City Administrator and a longer term, more permanent designation of an individual to serve as Acting City Administrator pending the appointment of a City Administrator and establishing a further distinction between the compensation applicable to such appointments;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION ONE: During the short term absence of the City Administrator or Acting City Administrator as a consequence of vacation, business outside of the City, illness and the like, the City Administrator or Acting City Administrator as the case may be shall have the authority to designate an individual to serve as the Administrator or Acting City Administrator.

SECTION TWO: Ordinance 2000-3346 and 2004-3592 are, hereby, repealed

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
